CAT 2019 will consist of 100 questions divided into 3 sections. It will test candidate's verbal ability, data interpretation, logical reasoning and quantitative aptitude skills. A total of 100 MCQ and Non-MCQ type questions will be asked. The duration of exam will be of 3 hours and each section will be allotted 1 hour time limit.
